Deposit, NY, (March 19, 2024) – The Chestnut Inn on Oquaga Lake in Deposit, NY is pleased to announce it has been inducted into Historic Hotels of America®, the official program of the National Trust for Historic Preservation for recognizing, celebrating, and promoting the finest historic hotels in the United States.

The Chestnut Inn is one of more than 300 hotels and resorts throughout the country that is recognized by Historic Hotels of America for preserving and maintaining its historic integrity, architecture, and ambiance.

The Chestnut Inn is a lakeside destination in the grand tradition of the Catskill resorts of 1940s and '50s. This fantastic historic hotel is located on the shores of Oquaga Lake, a private swimming lake in the foothills of New York's Catskill Mountains. The Chestnut Inn is part of a proud collection of properties operated by Settlers Hospitality that enjoy membership in Historic Hotels of America including The Settlers Inn, Ledges Hotel, Silver Birches and The Sayre Mansion.

To be selected for membership in Historic Hotels of America, a hotel must be at least 50 years old; designated by the U.S. Secretary of the Interior as a National Historic Landmark or listed in or eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places; and recognized as having historic significance.
